

Fourth Class Rates

While in Bancroft Hall, Plebes will:

1. Chop with their "eyes in the boat" and square corners throughout Bancroft Hall with the exception of the administrative spaces, the Midshipman Store, the 7th wing gym, the basement areas, and the post office.
2. Be in the Working Uniform of the Day or better until Study Hour; after which Blue and Gold Jogging Suits are authorized. Regulation PE gear is authorized for going to and from working out and sports practices only. If SIQ, PE gear will be authorized during the day.
3. Come to attention and greet each upperclassman, commissioned officer, and senior enlisted leader with appropriate rank and title.
4. Observe uninterrupted Study Hour on Sunday - Friday from 2000 to 2245 within Bancroft Hall, in Academic Buildings, Mitscher Hall, and Nimitz Library only. They will not attend any event during study hour unless authorized by the Superintendent. They may not carry out food or conduct personal workouts during this time.
5. Attend Company Blue and Gold unless excused by the Company Training Officer.
6. Attend all Saturday Morning Training unless an in-season varsity athlete or a Brigade Support Activity participant on movement order.
7. Be in the rack following Blue and Gold, but no later than 2300.
8. Know all daily rates to include:
 - The menus of three meals in advance
 - Conversational knowledge of three current newspaper articles
 - Knowing the names of the OOW and MOOW for the current day
 - Professional topics for the week
 - "The Days"
 - Names of all In Season Varsity Team Captains and all four strippers and above.
9. Be permitted to play video games on Town Liberty only. Other media privileges may be awarded only by the Company Commander.
10. Maintain professional relationships with upperclass Midshipmen. Dating upperclassmen and classmates within one's company is strictly prohibited.
11. Not use Second Class doors or Second and Third class ladder wells.
12. Maintain Bravo Conditions in rooms at all times.
13. Sound off with "attention on deck" for all O5s and above in passageways, and whenever any upper class or commissioned officer enters a room.
14. Not use the Company Wardroom.
15. Stand in a three-section weekend duty rotation.
16. Not use center doors entering Smoke Hall, Memorial Hall, or the Rotunda.
17. Be required to pass a weekly personnel and room inspection.
18. "Plebe" their covers at all times and in all locations on the yard. They are authorized to hold covers as they wish while off the yard on town liberty.

While in King Hall, Plebes will:

1. Use only the front 3 inches of their chairs, sitting at attention, with the exception of academic buildings and Fourth Class rooms.
2. Only use the center alley.
3. Chop with "eyes in the boat" and sound off while squaring corners.
4. Stand when a commissioned officer joins the mess.
5. Request permission from the Squad Leader and the most senior individual to join the mess if late or from a different squad.
6. Remain seated until excused by their squad leader following the dismissal at the anchor.
7. Not speak unless addressed by an upperclassman.

While using Yard Facilities, Plebes will:

1. Not sit in Drydock unless on Town Liberty. They may purchase food for carry-out in Drydock, but never during Study Hour. Steerage is off limits to plebes at all times.
2. Not utilize curved walkways on the Yard.
3. Attend two sporting events on the Yard per week.
4. Salute all commissioned officers and ALL upperclassmen on watch wearing an armband.

Off the Yard, Plebes will:

1. Commence Saturday Town Liberty from Company Commander Liberty Call until 2200 and Sunday from 0800 until 1300 to and from religious services only. (If not on duty status)
2. Not operate a motor vehicle, wear civilian clothes, or consume alcohol unless they are 21 years of age and on leave status.
3. Be permitted to run off the yard to conduct personal workouts only on town liberty (Must wear a reflective device before sunrise and after sunset).

Liberty for all classes will commence ONLY upon Company Commander Liberty Call.

Third Class Rates

In Bancroft Hall, Third Class will:

1. Be permitted to store civilian Clothes in their green Sea bag only and store on the bottom left shelf of their closets.
2. Be required to attend SMT every Saturday.
3. Remain in regulation PE gear or better (with shirts tucked in) during working hours (0700-1600).
4. Be permitted to wear Navy-Marine Corps related apparel only after working hours (1600).
5. Be permitted to have media privileges, including video games, DVDs, and music.
6. Participate in study hour from 2000-2300 Sunday through Thursday (to include Friday if UNSAT). They will be permitted to carry out food from Drydock and Steerage, but will not be able to conduct personal workouts at this time. They will not attend any event during study hour unless authorized by the Superintendent.
7. Maintain Bravo room conditions at all times.
8. Not utilize Second Class Doors or Second Class Ladder wells; third class are afforded full use of youngster ladder wells.
9. Come to attention when addressing a commissioned officer or the Midshipman Officer of the Watch.
10. Not use center doors entering Smoke Hall, Memorial Hall, or the Rotunda.
11. Sound off with "attention on deck" for all O5s and above in passageways, and whenever any commissioned officer enters a room.
12. Not have unduly familiar relationships with Plebes or Midshipmen within their own company.
13. Not use the Company Wardroom during weekdays unless granted permission directly by Company Commander.
14. Stand in a three-section weekend duty rotation.
15. Be required to pass a weekly personnel and room inspection.

In King Hall, Third Class will:

1. Use the center alley of King Hall only.
2. Stand when a commissioned officer joins the mess.
3. Request permission from the Squad Leader and the most senior individual to join the mess if late or from a different squad.
4. Remain seated until excused by their squad leader following the dismissal at the anchor.

While using Yard Facilities, Third Class will:

1. Be permitted to Dine in Drydock at any time after 1330 and before Study Hour on weekdays. Third Class may take out food from Steerage or Drydock during Study Hour, but may not sit. Third Class may utilize Drydock and Steerage at any time during Town Liberty.
2. Be permitted full use of all walkways on the Yard.
3. Salute all commissioned officers, the MOOW, and the RMOOWs.

Off the Yard, Third Class will:

1. Only be permitted to wear Civilian clothes when outside of the 22-mile radius AND on weekend or leave status. They are authorized Blue over Khaki for all sporting events unless otherwise directed.
2. Commence Town Liberty following Company Commander Liberty Call on Friday nights until 2200, Saturdays until 0100, and Sundays until 2000 (This ONLY applies to SAT Midshipmen who are not on duty status – Third Class who are UNSAT or PRT deficient will not have Friday night liberty).
3. Commence Weekend Liberty only after Company Commander Liberty call on Saturday. Weekend Liberty expires at 2000 on Sundays (This ONLY applies to SAT Midshipmen who are not on duty status - Third Class who are UNSAT or PRT deficient will lose half of their assigned weekends at each six week period).
4. Not operate a motor vehicle unless on leave status and will not drive on the Yard.
5. Be permitted to run off the yard to conduct personal workouts only on town liberty. (Must wear a reflective device before sunrise and after sunset)

Liberty for all classes will commence ONLY upon Company Commander Liberty Call.

Bancroft Hall Second Class Rates

In Bancroft Hall, Second Class will:

1. Be permitted to use coffee makers in rooms.
2. Be permitted to use all ladder wells.
3. Be authorized to store civilian clothes in closets.
4. Maintain Bravo room conditions at all times.
5. Remain in regulation PE gear or better (with shirts tucked in) during working hours (0700-1600).
6. Be permitted to wear Navy-Marine Corps related apparel only after working hours (1600).
7. May not use center doors entering Smoke Hall, Memorial Hall, or the Rotunda.
8. Observe Study Hour on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Sunday from 2000-2300. They will not attend any event during study hour unless authorized by the Superintendent. Second class rate using the Company Wardroom and Steerage during these hours.
9. Come to attention when addressing a commissioned officer and the Midshipman Officer of the Watch.
10. Sound off with "attention on deck" for all O5s and above in passageways, and whenever any commissioned officer enters their room.
11. Not rate any unduly familiar relationships with plebes or Midshipmen within their own company.
12. Stand in a four section weekend duty rotation.
13. Be required to pass a weekly personnel and room inspection.

In King Hall, Second Class will:

1. Rate King Hall alleyways dividing the tables on both port and starboard side of King Hall.
2. Not use First Class alleyways.
3. Stand when a commissioned officer joins the mess.
4. Request permission from the Squad Leader and the most senior individual to join the mess if late or from a different squad.
5. Remain seated until excused by their squad leader following the dismissal at the anchor.

While using Yard Facilities, Second Class will:

1. Rate the use off all doors and ladder wells.
2. Be permitted to operate motor vehicles but may not park or drive on the yard.
3. Salute all commissioned officers, the MOOW, and the RMOOWs.
4. Be permitted full use of all walkways on the Yard.
5. Be permitted to Dine in Drydock at any time after 1330 and before Study Hour on weekdays. Second Class may take out food from Drydock during Study Hour, but may not sit; however, dining in Steerage is authorized during Study Hour. Second Class may utilize Drydock and Steerage at any time during Town Liberty.
6. Be permitted to wear appropriate civilian clothes to sporting events, religious services, and all other activities on the yard during the weekend (If not on duty status).

Off the Yard, Second Class will:

1. Commence Town Liberty only after Company Commander Liberty Call on Tuesday and Friday nights until 2400, Saturdays until 0100, and Sundays until 2000 (This ONLY applies to SAT Midshipmen who are not on duty status – Second Class who are UNSAT or PRT deficient will not have Tuesday night liberty).
2. Commence Weekend Liberty only after Company Commander Liberty Call on Friday. Weekend Liberty ends on Sunday at 2000 (This ONLY applies to SAT Midshipmen who are not on duty status - Second Class who are UNSAT or PRT deficient will lose half of their assigned weekends at each six week period).
3. Be permitted to wear civilian clothes on liberty on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
4. Be permitted to run off the yard to conduct personal workouts only on town liberty. (Must wear a reflective device before sunrise and after sunset)
5. Not park on Annapolis City streets. They may only park in designated off-street parking such as the Naval Station parking spaces and Navy-Marine Corps Stadium.

Liberty for all classes will commence ONLY upon Company Commander Liberty Call.

Bancroft Hall First Class Rates

In Bancroft Hall, First Class will:

1. Be permitted to own refrigerators in rooms.
2. Be permitted to use the center doors of Smoke Hall and Memorial Hall.
3. Remain in regulation PE gear or better (with shirts tucked in) during working hours (0700-1600).
4. Be permitted to wear Navy-Marine Corps related apparel only after working hours (1600).
5. Maintain Bravo room conditions at all times.
6. Not use the center door when entering the Rotunda.
7. Observe Study Hour on Monday and Wednesday from 2000-2300. First Class may not attend any event during study hour unless authorized by the Superintendent. First class rate using the Company Wardroom, Steerage, and Dahlgren during these hours. First Class will *ultimately be responsible* for maintaining a quiet study environment in Bancroft Hall.
8. Come to attention when addressing a commissioned officer.
9. Sound off with "attention on deck" for all O5s and above in passageways, and whenever any commissioned officer enters their room.
10. Stand in a five section weekend duty rotation.
11. Be required to pass a weekly personnel and room inspection.
12. Not have unduly familiar relationships with Plebes or Midshipmen within their own company.
13. Will be held responsible for good order in Bancroft Hall at all times.

In King Hall, First Class will:

1. Be permitted to use all alleyways.
2. Stand when a commissioned officer joins the mess.
3. Request permission from the Squad Leader and the most senior individual to join the mess if late or from a different squad.
4. Remain seated until excused by squad leader following the dismissal at the anchor.

While using Yard Facilities, First Class will:

1. Park on the yard in designated spaces only.
2. Salute all commissioned officers, the MOOW, and the RMOOWs.
3. Be permitted the use of all walkways on the Yard.
4. Be permitted to dine in Drydock after 1330 until closing on Monday through Friday and from Liberty Call to closing on the weekend. They may also utilize Steerage at any time following dismissal at the anchor from noon meal.
5. Be permitted to wear civilian clothes to sporting events, religious services, and all activities on the yard during the weekend. (If not on duty status).

Off the Yard, First Class will:

1. Commence Town Liberty only after Company Commander Liberty Call on all Tuesday, Thursday and Friday nights until 2400; on Saturday until 0200; and on Sunday until 2400. (This ONLY applies to SAT Midshipmen who are not on duty status – First Class who are UNSAT or PRT deficient will not have Thursday night liberty).
2. Commence Weekend Liberty only after Company Commander Liberty Call on Friday. Weekend Liberty ends on Sunday at 2400 (This ONLY applies to SAT Midshipmen who are not on duty status- First Class who are UNSAT or PRT deficient will lose half of their assigned weekends at each six week period).
3. Be permitted to wear civilian clothes when on liberty on Friday, Saturday, or Sunday.
4. Be authorized to operate a motor vehicle.
5. Be permitted to run off the yard to conduct personal workouts only on town liberty (Must wear a reflective device before sunrise and after sunset).

Liberty for all classes will commence ONLY upon Company Commander Liberty Call.
